Basketweaving

A great project for beginning weavers, and a fun basket for experienced weavers, is the MARKET BASKET. This versatile basket measures 12" long x 5" high x 6" wide.

In this workshop, participants will be taught how to lay out a rectangular base, incorporate a "D" shaped handle as part of the construction, twine, upset stakes, weave a stop and start pattern, add and lash a rim.

The basket design lends itself and the handle to be stenciled or painted.

Participants should bring scissors, a tape measure (cloth is fine), a pencil, a dozen clip clothespins, towel, a spray bottle of water and a basin or pail for soaking reed.
