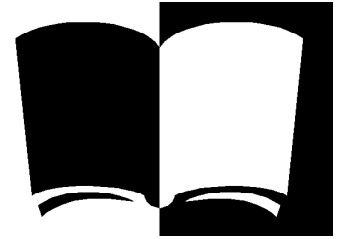

Photography for Kids Class

Penny Knobel-Besa will offer "Kids Art of Photography" at the AaCP Education Center in July for children ages 8 to 18 who enjoy taking photographs. Three sessions will cover basic photographic rules (some as easy as drawing tic tack toe), a field trip, photomontage, and discussions of matting and framing. An exhibition of the students' work will be held at the center. The class is geared towards developing the artistic eye of the student. Students must bring a working camera that they know how to operate. Classes meet July 26 from 1-3 p.m., July 28 from 9 to 11 a.m., and July 30 from 1-3 p.m. The class fee is \$60.
